MAJOR ART SHOW SCHEDULED FOR FESTIVAL OF THE ARTS IN JUNE

The Georgetown Symphony Society is presenting a weekend festival of music, lectures and art.

The month-long art show will involve members of the Williamson County Art Guild, Sun City Visual Arts, Central Texas Pastel Society, Taylor Art Guild and Bell Fine Arts clubs.

A portion of the sales from each art piece sold will go to benefit the performing arts.

The exhibit will be shown concurrently in three fine arts galleries in downtown Georgetown: The Framer's Gallery, 610 S. Main, The Golden Bough, 708 S. Austin Ave, Annarella, 800 S. Austin.

Show opening and Artists' Reception June 3, 2005 (First Friday) 6pm to 9pm, with music, refreshments and art.)

ENTRY DETAILS

Works in any medium qualify. All work must represent Handel, the works of Handel or any part thereof, or music in general. Call Sondra at the Golden Bough for help on subject matter. They must be framed and ready for hanging. They must be original to the artist submitting. Hung art must be less than 76 united inches. Art shall be labeled with

the artist name, contact info, & sale price. Limited to one or two pieces per artist. No limit to art clubs.

SALES

All work must be for sale. The art gallery will collect 40 % commission which includes the percentage going to the festival sponsors. Artists' payments will be made within 30 days after the show ends. All sales including sales tax and credit card fees will be handled by the gallery exhibiting the work. No work can be removed until the end of the show unless sold by the gallery".

CONDITIONS

All work shall be delivered to the Framer's Gallery by May 31st for distribution among the galleries. You will be notified which venue is displaying your work. Work not used must be picked up prior to the artists' reception unless other arrangements have been made. All work must be picked up at the end of the show, between the 27th and the 30th of June.

LIABILITY

Every care will be taken for the safety of all works of art. The participating Galleries and the Georgetown Symphony Society' and their agents will not be responsible for any loss or damage. Works will be handled and exhibited at the artist's risk.
