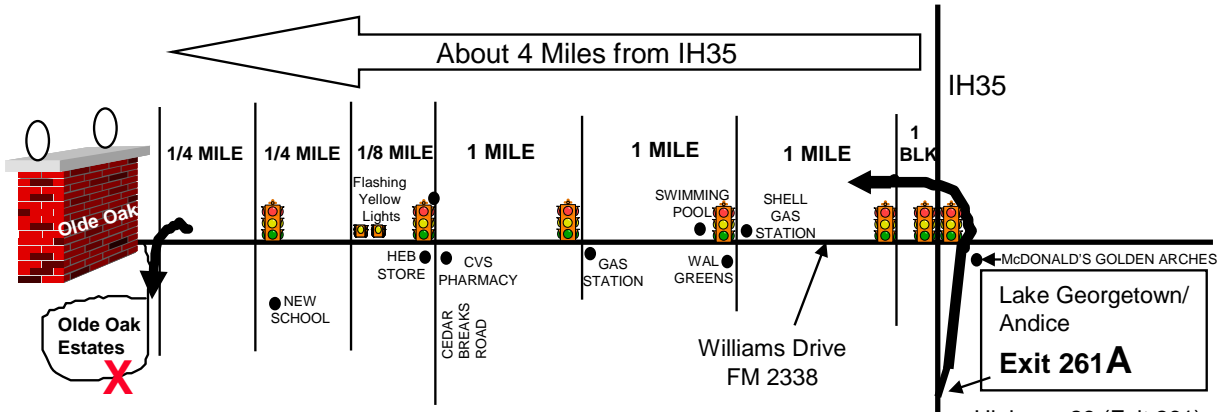

DIRECTIONS

Take IH35 North to the Lake Georgetown/Sun City Exit (**Exit 261A**). Go under the Highway 29 crossover.

Follow the access road (about 1/2 Mile) & turn left at the stoplight at the top of the grade (don't do the loop around).

The left turn will cross over IH35. You are now on Williams Drive heading West.

Drive approximately four miles West until you come to Olde Oak Estates. The Olde Oak Estates entrance is on the left side of the road. There is a brick wall with two post lights on top at the entrance. Turn left into the Olde Oak Estates entrance.

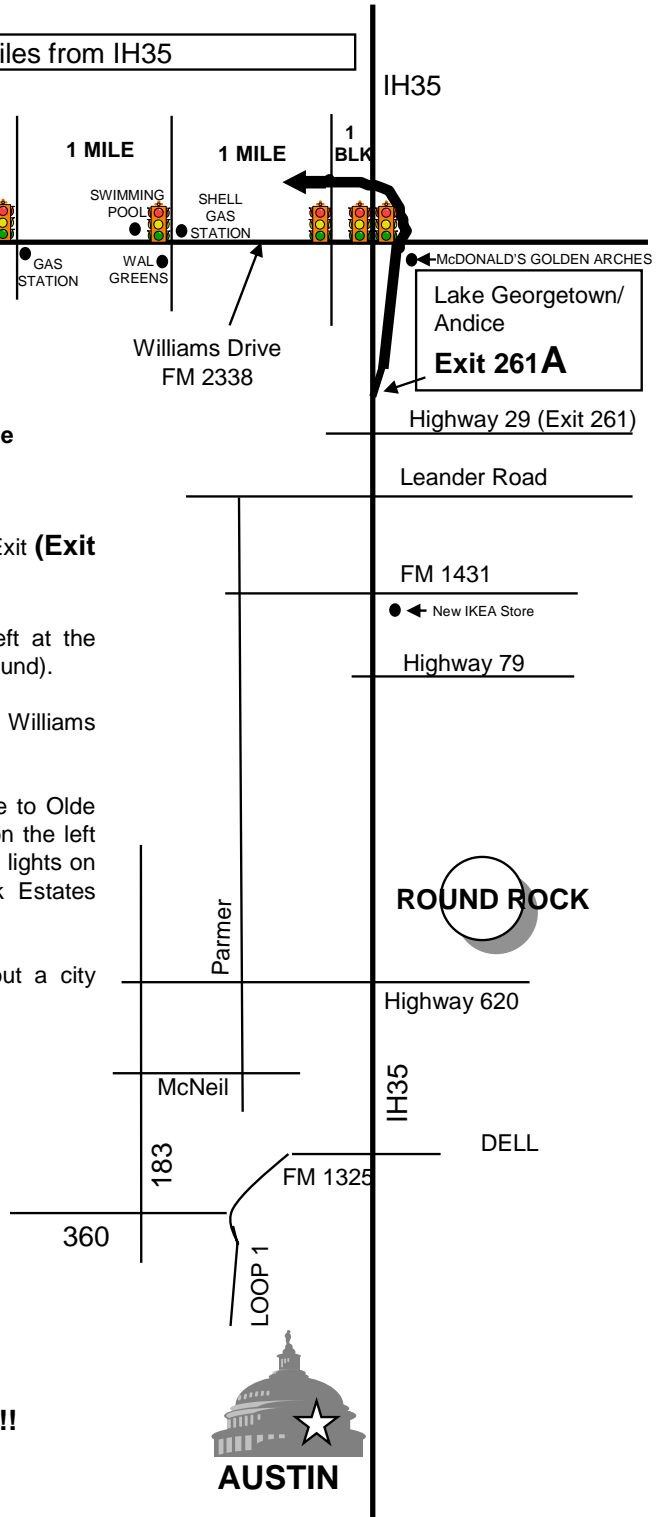
Drive straight to the back of the subdivision (about a city block).
