I hope you are rested and ready from the holidays because we will have many new opportunities for you to participate in WCAG programs in 2007. One of the big changes for 2007 is the relocation of the WCAG Gallery from 8th Street to The Framer's Gallery located at 610 South Main Street in Georgetown, TX. The WCAG space in the Framer's Gallery will normally be open from 10 a.m. – 5 p.m. Monday-Friday and Noon – 5 p.m. on Saturday, greatly expanding viewing hours for our exhibits.

Going hand-in-hand with this is the new re-energized public exhibition program being deployed under the leadership of Jackie Tarter, our new Exhibit Chair. Please see the **UPDATE ON EXHIBITIONS** below.

WCAG is updating its long range plan and is working with other groups to define requirements and options for an Art Center. One active group is the Downtown Georgetown Association (DGA). The DGA is studying the feasibility of locating the Art Center in or near downtown Georgetown. This mixed-use facility with courtyard demonstrations and gallery shows is intended to foster education in the arts by example. Cooperation with Artspace, the nation's largest not-for-profit developer of live/work space for artisans, is being considered to help guide the project forward. WCAG Parliamentarian, Larry McCormick, is Chair of the DGA study group.

- The usual fees and forms will be required for each piece submitted.

During the month of April, the WCAG will inaugurate an exhibition space in the new Georgetown Library. The exact opening date has not yet been set, but it will be late March or early April. The show will hang throughout April. We will have an opening reception with wine, food, and possibly music.

(The space can accommodate somewhat larger pieces.) We will get more detailed information about this show to you soon.
